## State Government sponsored program concludes mentoring; Startups pitched at Demo Day

JAIN Launchpad concluded one-on-one and group mentoring sessions for its startup portfolio under the JAIN Elevate WomEn Incubation Program. A cohort of 16 women entrepreneurs received 250+ hours of one-on-one coaching and 25+ knowledge sessions on various topics to help them understand the basics of running a company.

The coaches helped startups refine their business plans and navigate challenges associated with starting and growing a business.

After the sessions concluded, the startups prepared for their Demo Day on March 16th, 2023, held at the Conrad Bengaluru Hotel. The event offered female founders an opportunity to showcase their innovative products and services to curated set of potential investors and industry experts.

Dr. Chenraj Roychand, Founder Chairman JGI Group, talked about how new startups can rise to great heights even though it starts from scratch. There are ten principles he shared: Talent, Never Give Up, Dream, Idea, Networking, Focus, Time Management and Self-Management, Do Not Complicate, Keep it Simple and Success.

Mr. Madan Padaki, Founder & CEO of 1BRIDGE and President of TiE Bangalore, also addressed the startups and cited Saras Saraswathy's Principle of Effectuation and explained it through the story of Virgin Atlantic and Boeing's collaboration. He shared his journey, struggles, and how he made it up through making difficult decisions.

**Background:** JAIN Launchpad received the sanction order in July 2022 to provide the much needed incubation support to female founders in tier 2 and tier 3 cities through JAIN Elevate WomEn Incubation Program from KITS, Dept. of El, IT, BT and S&T, Government of Karnataka. 16 startups were selected from over 100 applications after rigorous outreach activities such as online awareness, sessions, meetups, and roadshows. The roadshows were conducted in various parts of the state, such as Tumkur, Ramanagara, Mangalore, etc.,

#### New seed funding scheme rolls out at JAIN Launchpad

In February 2023, JAIN Launchpad rolled out Startup India Seed Fund Scheme (SISFS), which is designed to provide financial assistance to startups for proof-of-concept and prototype development, product testing, market entry, and commercialization. The program, supported by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) and Ministry of Commerce and Industry, facilitate startups to graduate to a level where they can raise investments or loans from angel investors, venture capitalists, or commercial banks.

This funding support allows startups to receive grants/equity/debt upto INR 20 lakhs to validate their POC, and upto INR 50 lakhs to launch, commercialize, or scale their business.

## Government of Karnataka extends last date to apply for seed funding scheme-ELEVATE 2023

The Government of Karnataka commenced its flagship program, "ELEVATE 2023" (Idea2PoC Grant-in-aid seed funding scheme upto INR 50 Lakhs for Startups as per Karnataka Startup Policy 2022-2027). A call for applications was launched on 3rd February 2023; the program aims to identify the most innovative startups across the



State and ELEVATE them to the next level of entrepreneurship.

ELEVATE 2023 was started in 2017 to nurture ventures in various sectors such as biotechnology, IT, nanotechnology, and agriculture. Since then, JAIN Launchpad has been part of this program as a Jury member.

The program has a special focus on startups led by women, rural entrepreneurs, and those working on social impact solutions. Through this program, the Government of Karnataka aims to promote innovation, create employment opportunities, and boost economic growth in the state.
